

# DN Manuscript European Letters *DN\_Europ.pdf*

All of the EFI Manuscript fonts have the European variations of the Latin alphabet. Just select the DN Manuscript font you want to use, and follow the instructions in your word processor's Help. Or ...

On a Windows computer, you use the numeric keypad (the small pad on the right of the keyboard). For each European letter, hold the Alt key and type 0nnn on the numeric keypad.

On a Macintosh computer, you use Shift (S) and Option (O) keys, in combination with one or more letters, to produce the European letters. There is a problem, however - there is no way to enter the Y acute and y acute characters on the Macintosh.

**NOTE:** If using Microsoft Word, be sure to turn off AutoCorrect features that Replace: 1) Straight Quotes with Smart Quotes; 2) Ordinals with Superscript; 3) Fractions with Fraction Character.
